

COMMON COUNCIL
11/13/2017

The Common Council of the City of Park Falls met in regular session in the council chambers of the Park Falls city hall at 5:00 PM on Monday, November 13, 2017. Mayor Daniel Leitl called the meeting to order and the following members were present:

The minutes of the previous Council meeting of 10/9/17 were presented. Moved by Alderman Wartgow and seconded by Alderman Hoffman to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried.

Alderman Dryer presented Personnel Committee report.

Alderman Wartgow presented the Finance Committee report. Moved by Alderman Wartgow and seconded by Alderman Hogue to approve payment of the bills totaling \$583,136.13. Motion carried.

Alderman Thier presented the minutes of the 11/6/17 BPW meeting. Moved by Alderman Thier and seconded by Alderman Mader to accept the minutes as presented. Motion carried. Moved by Alderman Mader and seconded by Alderman Thier to approve the BPW's recommendation to accept the land donation from Luethmer with no restrictions on the use or future sale of this land. Motion carried.

Alderman Mader presented the minutes of the 11/6/17 Public Services Committee meeting. Moved by Alderman Mader and seconded by Alderman Bablick to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried. Moved by Alderman Wartgow and seconded by Alderman Hogue to approve the Public Service Committee's recommendation for a 3-year renewal of the Solid Waste Transfer Station Lease Agreement. Motion carried. Liquor license applications were presented to the Council. Moved by Alderman Wartgow and seconded by Alderman Mader to grant a Class A Combination Intoxicating Liquor and Fermented Malt Beverage License to Kwik Trip. Motion carried. Moved by Alderman Thier and seconded by Alderman Hogue to grant a Class B Intoxicating Liquor License to the Gastropub. Motion carried.

Mayor Leitl appointed Grant Schuenemann to the position of part-time police officer. Moved by Alderman Hoffman and seconded by Alderman Hogue to confirm the mayor's appointment conditional upon a successful background check, drug screen, and physical fitness test. Motion carried. Mayor Leitl presented the visitor parking policy for overnight street parking from November 1 to May 1.

City Attorney Schoenborn presented the following ordinance:

Moved by Alderman Mader and seconded by Alderman Wartgow to adopt the ordinance as presented. Motion carried. She reported that the 2nd Avenue Project Clean Water Fund loan documents will be available for the 12/4/17 Council meeting.

Chief of Police Straetz reported on the drug disposal program and drug warrants issued during October.

Water & Street Superintendent Hilgart reported that two surplus dump trucks are for sale on the Wisconsin Surplus Online Auction, and two surplus pickups are advertised for sale by bid in the Price County Review.

In public comment, it was noted that causes of the water leaks on the 5th Avenue Project are still being analyzed.
