

## NOTICE TO ALL PRICE COUNTY DOG OWNERS

Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to Sections 95.21(2), 174.05 and 174.07(1)(b), Wisconsin Statutes, the owner of a dog more than five months of age on January 1 or five months of age this year, shall annually, prior to April 1, or on or before the date the dog becomes five months of age, pay the dog license tax and obtain a license. Notice is hereby further given that evidence that the dog is currently immunized against rabies (by a veterinarian) must be presented before a license will be issued.

The dog license fee in Price County is as follows:

- 1 or 2 neutered or spayed dogs is \$15.00 per dog.
- 1 or 2 intact male or female dogs is \$20.00 per dog.
- 3 to 12 dogs qualify for a multiple dog license for \$35.00, with an additional fee of \$3.00 for each dog in excess of 12.

**PENALTIES:** A late fee of \$5.00 may be assessed to the owner of each dog five months of age or older who fails to obtain a dog license by April 1.

An owner who fails to have a dog licensed and vaccinated against rabies as required by statute may be made to forfeit not less than \$50.00 or more than \$200.00.
